

Ten Commandment Monument in Dysart

Knights of Columbus Council # 5557 in Dysart, Saskatchewan, recently erected a “Ten Commandment Monument.” This was done as part of “Project Moses”. This is the second Ten Commandment Monument installed in Sask as a result of Knights of Columbus efforts. In January 2008, the members of Dysart Council heard about Project Moses from District Deputy Joe Brodner. At that meeting it was decided to go ahead with this project and erect a Ten Commandment Monument outside the Church in Dysart. Through many fundraising efforts and a community appeal in August 2008, their monument arrived.



Several Brother Knights were involved in the project from fundraising to site preparation to actual installation of the monument as shown on the left.

Shown in the picture on the right, is Brother Joe guiding the monument to its' base outside of Saint John the Baptist Roman Catholic church in Dysart. The Knights of Dysart can be proud as this is only the second such monument in Saskatchewan and in fact in all of Canada.



Dysart is a small community with a population of around 200 with Knights of Columbus Council # 5557 with 33 members.
