**Discing** is a sport not that familiar to all. Teams are comprised of four members similar to curling. The discs used are 10 inches in diameter and 2 inches thick made of fur or oak wood. They are finished with a shellac on the bottom side and painted different colors for identification on the sides and top. They are held in your hand and delivered by sliding on the floor from one end of the sheet to the other. Scoring again is the same as in curling. Discing is played indoors and so those of all ages can participate.
