

Brother Knights,

We have all been touched by the catastrophic disaster within Haiti. There is a tremendous need for financial assistance to meet the demand for the basics of food, water, medical aid and shelter.

The Knights of Columbus Charitable Foundation Board of Directors had a meeting on the weekend and set up a facility for Councils and individuals to donate to the Haiti Disaster Relief. The Foundation will issue charitable receipts for all donations in excess of twenty dollars.

We will direct those monies to a relief organization that is eligible to be included in the federal government's "matching" program (i.e. whatever Canadians donate towards Haiti Disaster Relief within a certain window of time, the federal government will match). It is our understanding that this matching program is only available until early February so we ask that you forward your cheque this week in order to ensure that your donation will qualify for government matching.
