RULES & INFORMATION

- 1) Rules committee: Joe Loch, Dave Kopera, and Darcy Myers the Cooke Golf Course professional.
- 2) Men golfers play from the **YELLOW** tees, ladies from the **RED** tees.
- 3) The RCGA rules will apply except as modified by local rules identified on the score card and as follows:
 - Winter rules are in effect. (**fairways only**) Lift, clean and place within one club length not closer to the hole.
 - Please play ready golf.
 - Please replace all divots, repair ball marks on the greens and kindly tamp down cleat marks after putting.
 - Respect wishes and directions of the course marshal!!
 - Both lakes on holes # 3 & 5 fairway are lateral water hazards.
The pond on #12 is a lateral water hazard. Please do not hold up play by trying to retrieve your ball from the hazard. Proceed immediately to the designated drop area, take a one stroke penalty, make a proper drop and play your next shot.
 - All putts must be holed out. (**NO GIMMIES**)
 - If in doubt about any shot/lie play an alternate shot and get a ruling from the Rules Committee.
 - Maximum number of strokes on any hole is 10. Once you have accumulated 10 strokes pick up your ball and go to the next hole.
- 4) The playing foursomes for the first day are made up according to the handicaps supplied and any special requests that were made at the time of the entry was filed. On the second day players will be placed in flights.
- 5) Flight Prizes – 4 prizes in each flight will be awarded as soon as winners have been determined. Specialty prizes will be available on the first day for the following events:
 - Low gross men and ladies.
 - Low net men and ladies (proof of handicap required)
 - Closest to the pin for ladies and men (hole # 4)
Hole # 12 will have a hole in one prize or closest to the pin.
 - Long drive hole # 9 for men (49 and Under/50 – 65/over 65 years of age
 - Ladies long drive hole # 3 (under 49/50 and over)
- 6) Gross Prize: Ties will be broken as follows:
 - The best last 18 holes (second round) If still tied
 - The best last 9 holes (second round) If still tied
 - The best last 6 holes(second round) If still tied
 - The best last 3 holes (second round) If still tied
 - The above are all total – hole scores. If still tied
 - The best hole in sequence (i.e. 18, 17, 16, etc)
- 7) Net Prize: Ties will be broken as follows:
 - Best last 9 holes less ½ handicaps. If still tied
 - Best first 9 holes less ½ handicap. If still tied
 - Best last 6 holes less 1/3 handicap. If still tied
 - Best last 3 holes less 1/6 handicap.
